Classified Staff-ONLY

As classified site employees, you play an important role at our school sites in fostering the social, emotional and behavioral well-being of our students. Your participation in site-based *Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS)* professional development alongside certificated staff is essential to successful implementation (refer to Sept 2019 memo):

- If you are a 8.94 or 9.3 month classified employee, you will be paid to attend the two hour PBIS training.
- If you are a 10+ month classified employee and are already working, you will attend the two hour PBIS training.
- If your regular work hours do not include the 8:00-10:00 a.m. time frame, you will be paid for any additional time beyond your work day.
